

Search Strategies Tips

System Search Defaults(Automatic Retrieval)

Variances	Examples		Phrase Searching
2 or more words	Automatically recognized with an imposition of the Digital MarketingDigital and MarketingAir and Pollution		If you this be recognized as exact phrase enter your search terms in quotation mark ("")
Singular and Plural	Nurse Nurses Child Children		"Digital Marketing" "Air Pollution"
Comparative and Superlative	ThinThinnerThinnest Good BetterBest	Lemmatization	
Spelling Variance(US vs British English)	ColorColour Defense Defence		

Search Strategies Tips Boolean and Proximity Operators

Boolean	Examples
And	Narrow your search and retrieve records containing all of the words All the words must be present Metabolites and indigenous will only find records containing both these words
Or	Broaden a search and retrieve records containing any of the words or both Indigenous or natural will find records containing indigenous only, natural only or both words.
Not	Narrow a search and retrieve records that do not contain the term following it. Pollution not sound Retrieves all records of pollution but not sound

Search Strategies Tips Boolean and Proximity Operators

Proximity	Examples
NEAR/n(#) N/n(#)	Terms appear within a specified number of words apart, in any order Marketing NEAR/5 Effectiveness Will find marketing effectiveness, effectiveness of marketing, effectiveness level of marketing etc
PRE/n(#) P/n(#)	Terms appear within a specified number of words apart, in the specified order . Attention PRE/3 Disorder Will find Attention Deficit Disorder, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder But not Not Disorder With Attention Deficit

Search Strategies Truncation and WildCards

Truncation/ Wildcards	Examples
asterisk (*)	The truncation character can be used at the end (right-hand truncation), or in the middle of a word. The maximum number of characters that will be retrieved is 5. Search for Econom* will find Economy, Economist, Economic, Economical Search for Medic! will find medical, medicine, medication, medically
question mark symbol (?)	Wildcard character , used to replace any single character, either inside or at the right end of the word. Search t?re will find ti re, t y re, t o re

Frequently Used Search Fields

Field	Field Code	Example
Abstract	AB	AB(food)
Author	AU	AU(morrison)
Date of publication	PD	PD(20170412)
Document title	TI	TI(climate change)
Location as subject	LOC	LOC(china)
Person as subject	PER	PER(thatcher)
Publication title	PUB	PUB(wall street journal)
Subject heading	SU	SU(higher education)
Year of publication	YR	YR(2018)
